Car Insurance Law Changes

In June of 2020 our Michigan lawmakers put into place an entirely new set of laws surrounding Personal Injury Protection (PIP) in our car insurance. Because of the Covid crisis, this news passed without notice for many seniors. And even those who did hear about the changes were often left confused and unsure of what it might mean to use these new options.

Is it wise to opt out of PIP by using the Medicare "Option 6" since it does save money? What is the individual giving up and gaining? Participants will learn what they need to know to make an informed choice.

About the presentationWhat are the reactions?

During the presentation, when asked how many attendees had been briefed by their insurance companies about these changes, fewer than 1 out of 10 raised their hands.


