BURRITO BOWL

Ingredients

- 1 cup cooked chicken
- 1/2 cup cooked rice
- chopped tomatoes
- 1/4 cup cooked black beans
- 2 TBSP shredded cheese
- 1 TBSP taco seasoning
- 1 TBSP finely sliced or diced red onion
- 1/2 avocado, sliced or chopped

Instructions:

1. Cook anything that needs to be cooked. Chop or shred your chicken, then put it into a small mixing bowl. Sprinkle some taco

seasoning over it and toss to coat; set it aside.

- 2. Prep the other ingredients. Then grab a personal-sized serving bowl and put your cooked rice into it.
- 3. Top the rice with the chicken, beans, cheese, pico de gallo, onion, and avocado.
- 4. Sprinkle some taco seasoning over the beans and add a generous drop of plain Greek yogurt or sour cream on top; add chili flakes for an extra kick along with some hot sauce.
- 5. Finish your bowl off with some fresh chopped parsley or cilantro, and serve it with a lime wedge.



For Serving

- 1 TBSP plain Greek yogurt or sour cream
- 1/2 cup prepared pico de gallo or 1 TBSP fresh chopped parsley or cilantro
 - Lime wedge
 - Sprinkle of chili flakes ٠
 - Drizzle of hot sauce
